LIST ספרים

Members of the Kollel should keep an eye out for an email with the full Sefarim list in the coming days, if you have not already received it.

A Chumash (Bamidbar/D'varim) with Rashi, for שתיים מקרא (Boys are Ma'avir Sedra before each Shabbos). The High School Kollel will be learning Meseches Brachos.

For those campers who will be in camp for Tisha B'av, which falls during first session: קינות (The Kollel has קינות available, but bringing one with an English translation is highly recommended.)

Those who own a mini-Shas are encouraged to bring it.

Bringing a Jastrow is highly recommended.

Members of the Kollel are highly encouraged to begin studying the משניות of the chosen mesechet in advance of the summer.

The Kollel has a whole Beis Medrash filled with seforim for everyone to use, and you are more than welcome to bring with you any other sefarim you plan to learn on Shabbosim and Bein Ha'sdarim. Please note that each member of the HS Kollel will be asked to say Divrei Torah once or twice on Shabbosim throughout the summer, so bring along any sefarim that will assist you in preparing these Divrei Torah.



NUT FREE CAMP

Our first priority is your safety and health. **We are a nut-free camp.** We have many talmidim who have SEVERE allergies. TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM MORASHA

- **Luggage Pick Up:** All Kollel members must ship their luggage via Campify at www.campifyus.com/morasha. Luggage will not be allowed to be placed under the bus.
- **Bus Departure to Morasha:** All Kollel participants will leave on **Tuesday, June 30** from one of our bus departure locations: New Jersey, Long Island, Westchester, or Newark Airport bus.

MEDICAL

Your child's health and safety is our #1 priority at Camp Morasha. It is mandatory for your child to be examined by a physician before arriving to camp. We must know whether your child may participate in all activities and whether there is a need for special attention or diet. The online Health History form must be completed by a parent online. The Physician Exam and Insurance / Pharmacy card forms must be uploaded to your MyMorasha account no later than June 15th. Please note: **No camper will be permitted to board the bus without having submitted these completed medical forms.**

It is in your child's best interest to inform us of pre-conditions (e.g. asthma). We must know in advance regarding allergies or any such medical conditions in order to give your child the proper care. Information will be confidential and will be dealt with in a professional manner with your child's care our primary concern. If the need arises. Should any camper require treatment for lice, you may either take your child home for private treatment or have your child treated at our infirmary at \$40 per hour.
