ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES - RULES & REGULATIONS

1) BASKETBALL

- a) SDP Banim, Alufim, and Ilanot Banim: 20 minute running halves; all others: 15 minute running halves. The last 2 minutes of each half in all groups will be played stop time.
- b) Every team member must play at least three minutes.
- c) If time runs out, the game is official after at least one half of the game has been played.
- d) Each team has three time outs a game, each lasting one minute.
- e) One and one goes into effect on the seventh team foul within a half. 2 shots on the 10th foul per half.
- f) A player fouls out of the game on his/her fifth personal foul.
- g) One team will be responsible for keeping score and fouls; the other team will keep time.
- h) Overtimes will be 3 minutes. 2 minutes running, last minute stop time.

2) SOFTBALL

- a) SDP and Machzor Bet - 6 innings; Machzor Aleph - 5 innings.
- b) A minimum of three full innings will constitute a game.
- c) Each team member must play in the field at least one inning and have at least one turn at bat.
- d) A person who is "substituted out" may not go back into the game.
- e) No inning may begin later than five minutes before the end of the period. The inning must be completed.
- f) Prior to the game, the counselors and the judge must review the ground rules of that particular field, in accordance with the accepted practice of that field, e.g. ground rule double if ball goes into bushes etc.
- g) Throwing the bat is an automatic out; no sliding.
- h) Tagging up from third only.

3) VOLLEYBALL & NEWCOMB

- a) A team must win two out of three games to decide the match. All three games must be played.
- b) 15 points are needed to win a game. (Nitzanim and Shtilim Newcomb play 11 point games.) A team must win by two points.
- c) Each team member must play at least one full game.
- d) Net ball on a serve is out, a ball on the line is good, the pole is out, no double taps, maximum three taps, if the ball hits the net it counts as a tap.
- e) A player cannot put a foot into other team's court. A player's hand can cross over the net only 1) to follow through on a legal hit, 2) to block an opponent's shot after the opponent has hit the ball. Touching the net is never allowed.

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- 4) HOCKEY
- a) Time: 2 15-minute running periods, the last minute per period is stop time.
 - b) Where needed, the judge must mark the creases in front of the goal nets periodically during the game.
 - c) Game is official after half the game has been completed.
 - d) One 3 minute, sudden-death overtime will be played if needed.
 - e) Each team receives one time out per game.
 - f) Each team member must play at least three minutes per game.
- 5) MACHANAYIM AND DODGEBALL
- a) Standard camp procedure for these activities, which must be discussed by the counselors and the judge before the game, will be in effect.
 - b) Three games must be played.
 - c) Games should be played with all balls live.
 - d) Substitutes may only enter at the beginning of a new game.
- 6) KICKBALL
- a) Seven innings constitute a game.
 - b) A minimum of four innings with three outs each must be played.
- 7) TENNIS
- a) One set (consisting of six games) decides the match; except if 5-5, seven games decide the match.
 - b) No player may appear in more than one match.
 - c) A ball on the line is good.
 - d) At 6-6, the players play a 7-point tiebreak.
 - e) The winning team must win by two.
- 8) BBK
- a) Seven inning game.
 - b) The shot at the basket counts as soon as the ball leaves the shooter's hands.
 - c) A minimum of four innings with three outs each must be played.

THE SAME CAMPERS MUST NOT PLAY A GIVEN GAME TWICE IN ONE DAY.

PRESENTATIONS AND PROJECTS

CHEER: Each team will present a team cheer in the gym on Day I following supper. The cheer will be judged on the basis of: overall presentation, lyrics, shtick and appeal of song. (Musical accompaniment is permissible.) The Cheer should be used at activities, i.e. when a team wins a game.

MACCABIA: Alufim-Alufot and SDP will participate in a number of challenging races and competitions. Rosters for the races must be turned in to the Coordinating Committee by supper of Day I.

RABBATTON: Ilanot will be divided into four groups per team. Each group must be assigned a counselor. Total of 4 counselors per team. Each group will start at its assigned Bondi according to the following schedule:

א 1,4,7,10, ב 2, 5, 8, 11 and ג 3, 6, 9, 12. At each Bondi the group will have three minutes to complete an assigned task and then will have fifteen seconds to proceed to the next Bondi. Each group can earn up to five points per activity.

SHIELD: The shield should embody symbols associated with the themes of the teams and is to be presented on the second night. It is to be constructed of wood and will be permanently mounted. The Shield will be judged on the basis of the following: artistic appeal, quality of workmanship, representation of theme, originality of concept, durability, and presentation. The presentation is to consist of a detailed explanation of the Shield, and how it expresses the theme. Each presentation should not exceed two (2) minutes. A presentation of more than two minutes will result in an automatic point deduction.

THEME PRESENTATION: Each team will present its theme in the form of a skit. The Dramatics and Education staffs will be available for consultation. Each presentation should be approximately 5-8 minutes. Any team exceeding the time limit will be penalized accordingly. They will be judged on the basis of creativity and originality, entertainment value, development of theme, execution, and camper involvement. This presentation will take place the second night. All scripts must receive approval of coordinating committees by 8:00 P.M. the first night. Staff may be used in the production as per discretion of the team.

DANCE PRESENTATION: Each team is to present a 2-3 minute dance on the second night. The dance will be judged on the basis of representation of theme, execution, and creativity. A short presentation, not to exceed one (1) minute, explaining the dance is recommended. All dances must be approved by Shayne Schwed by 8:00 P.M. the first night.

CAMP PROJECT: Each team will create two designated signs for specific buildings in camp. The project will be made from wood and will be judged on the basis of aesthetic appeal, creativity, clarity, use of material and presentation. The project will be judged at 3:00 PM on Day III and presented that evening in the gym.

SHIRIAH: Each team will present two songs. The songs will be judged on the basis of overall presentation, knowledge of words, camper participation, and lasting value to the camp. Each team will also present a comic song. This song must be submitted to the Coordinating Committee for approval, no later than breakfast - Day III. Shiriah will take place the third evening. All other songs must be approved by Sandy Sudberg by breakfast Day II.

SHEALTIEL: The Shealtiel will consist of a set of questions based on material that will be distributed. Each team will select one boy and one girl per division to compete. Shealtiel will take place on the second night.

BERACHOT BEE: Each division will be tested for Color War points as follows: Machzor Aleph: Al Hamichya, Machzor Bet and Machon: Ya'aleh Ve'yavoh. In addition, each camper will be asked Brachot Rishonot from a list which will be distributed on Campus. The Berachot Bee will take place during the afternoon on Day III.

D'VAR TORAH: Each team will present one D'var Torah during Color War. All Divrei Torah must be submitted to Coordinating Committee by lunch Day I. The D'var Torah must be presented by a camper (not Machon) and must not exceed three minutes. It will be judged on the basis of content and presentation. The D'var Torah will be presented at lunch every day.

SHALHEVET: Each team must submit ten (10) articles (one per division) for Shalhevet by the second day lunch as per instructions.

MATMON SEFORIM: Each team will select three boys and three girls per division in Machzor Bet to compete. The Matmon will take place during Sheurim on Day II for Alufim-Alufot and on Day III for Ilanot. Each group will have forty (40) minutes to answer as many questions as possible from a list of 25 with the use of any source or reference material in the library. There will be a library orientation for all participants in Matmon Seforim on Day I.

MBP - MISHNAYOT BEAL PEH: Each team will choose three boys and three girls (one from younger, and two from older Shtilim for a total of 6). These campers will memorize and study five given Mishnayot relating to theme. The judges will randomly choose two of the mishnayot to be explained and recited. The testing will take place during the afternoon on Day III.

MACHON MARATHON: To be held on Day III immediately following Activity III. This involves 1 girl and 1 boy per team. It is suggested that the Marathon participants do not participate in Activity III on Day III.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELORS:

- 1) COUNSELORS MUST FIRST FULFILL THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES TO THEIR BUNKS BEFORE PROCEEDING TO MORASHIA EVENTS.
- 2) It is the major duty of all counselors and generals to encourage all work to be done by campers. Counselors are to serve primarily as advisors.
- 3) No articles are to be removed from the "A" building, H.C. Huts, Dining Room, Arts & Crafts shops or Mercazia without prior permission from those in charge. All items removed with permission must be returned to their proper places. Points will be deducted for items not returned and if the assigned art areas are not cleaned daily.

REMEMBER ALWAYS: Stress is not on competition, for competition alone can arouse ill feelings and resentment. Emphasis should be on the themes delineated and sportsmanship. All activities should be conducted with the spirit of good fellowship rather than with a feeling of rivalry. The maxim of Morashia stresses the fact that to win is not as important as to compete to the best of your ability. Therefore, all counselors are requested to make certain that all campers, no matter how weak in athletics, shall participate. Any infraction of this rule will result in a substantial loss of points for the team involved.

Individual judges may recommend an award or deduction of up to five (5) points per incident for attitude, spirit, sportsmanship, supervision etc.

Discussions and protests of controversial decisions should never be held in the presence of campers.

BUNK CLEAN-UP SCHEDULE: Bunk inspection will be done by the division heads or head counselors. Points may be deducted at the discretion of the inspector.

COVERAGE:

Bunks MUST be covered during the morning cleanup, rest hour, evening preparation, and bedtime. Responsibility for this coverage will be divided among the teams such that each team will be responsible for a set number of bunks. A list of the covering counselors is to be presented to each H.C. and to the Coordinating Committee each evening by Maariv. Severe deductions will be made for any bunk left uncovered.

TEFILAH:

In the Bet Knesset, campers and counselors will sit by bunk. Baalei Tefila will be chosen according to the regular rotation. No camper or counselor may absent himself/herself from Tefila.

STRUCTURE OF THE TEAMS:

- 1) Counselors, as well as campers, are members of their respective teams and will be so judged.
- 2) Each team is advised to designate coordinators in the areas of Art, Sports, Track and Field, and Swimming. The Art Coordinators are to submit requests for all art supplies to the Coordinating Committee at Breakfast, Day I. There should be divisional coordinators for sports, track and swim.

GENERAL RULES:

ENTRIES: Complete written lists of starting and substitute players in games must be submitted to the judges before the start of the game. If entries are not submitted on time, the event may be forfeited at the discretion of the judges. Entries may be changed only upon the consent of the judges. Any camper may be barred from participation in events by the medical staff.

Scores from all morning sports events are to be handed in by designated team members by lunch that day. Teams responsible for equipment are also responsible for scores. All scores are to be given to the campus supervisors or the Assignment Committee.

DINING ROOM: Relaxation is essential during mealtime. General decorum must be maintained and the teams will be judged accordingly. At least two generals must be at each meal.

O.D.: The O.D. schedule will follow regular rotation. Generals may make substitutions only with permission of the Head Counselors.

REST HOUR: Rest hour will be strictly enforced. No camper will be excused from the bunk without the permission of the Head Counselors.

CHANGES: All activities, rules and regulations are subject to change without prior notice at the discretion of the Coordinating Committee. However, this will not be done unless an unusual circumstance indicates the necessity for such a change.

FORFEITS: Teams must be ready on time when the event is called or forfeit said event.

PRORATING: A modified prorating system (Olympic scoring) will be used for all sports except where otherwise noted. 20% of the points will go to the winner. The remainder of the points will be divided on a per-cent basis. In general, the following will be the total point value for each sport:

NITZANIM.....	30
SHTILIM.....	35
ILANOT.....	40
ALUFIM-ALUFOT.....	45
S.D.P.....	50

In case of shut-outs, or wide point differences, certain adjustments are made in the prorating system. The Scoring Committee may be consulted for details.

CURFEW: CAMPERS AND COUNSELORS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO STAY UP AFTER CURFEW, NOR ARE THEY TO ARISE BEFORE REVEILLE, WITHOUT SPECIAL PERMISSION FROM THE HEAD COUNSELORS AND THE COORDINATING COMMITTEE. A limited number of campers, Ohed members and counselors may be allowed an extended curfew. Their names MUST be submitted on a special curfew extension form to the Coordinating Committee by 7:30 P.M. Names should be listed in order of preference. Extended curfews will be for one hour only unless otherwise specified. Generals and Lieutenant Generals have an automatic one hour extension.

PROTESTS: Protests must be submitted in writing, signed by the counselors supervising the activity, and countersigned by the General. The protest is to be submitted to the Coordinating Committee by the mealtime immediately following the event in question.

PREPARATION AND PROMPTNESS: Teams must report to activities promptly. All campers in the division must be present at the activity of their division (unless the camper is taking part in another supervised activity). Failure to be prompt may lead to the forfeiture of points. Participants should wear, wherever and whenever possible, the team color.

MEALS: No camper, counselor, or General is to be absent from any meal without the prior permission of the Head Counselor and Coordinating Committee. Therefore, no food is to be removed from the Dining Room and no meals may be brought out.
