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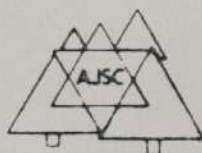

ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES - RULES AND REGULATIONS

1) BASKETBALL

- a) Machon Banim, Alufim & Ilanot Banim: 20 minute running halves; all others: 15 minute running halves. The last 2 minutes of each half in all groups will be played stop time.
- b) Every team member must play at least three minutes.
- c) If time runs out, the game is officially over after at least one half of the game has been played. The referee will have final discretion as to whether a game will be stopped prematurely.
- d) Each team has three time outs a game, each lasting one minute.
- e) "One and One" goes into effect on the seventh team foul within a half. 2 shots on the 10th foul per half.
- f) A player fouls out of the game on his/her fifth personal foul.
- g) One team will be responsible for keeping score and fouls; the other team will keep time.
- h) Overtimes will be 3 minutes, 2 minutes running, last minute stop time.
- i) All technical fouls will result in two foul shots and possession of the ball.

2) SOFTBALL

- a) Machon and Machzor Bet - 6 innings; Machzor Aleph - 5 innings.
- b) A minimum of three full innings will constitute a game.
- c) A maximum of 10 players will play the field. All team members will have a spot in the batting order. Team members will rotate in the field.
- d) Each team member must play in the field at least one inning and have at least one turn at bat.
- e) No inning may begin later than 5 minutes before the end of the period. The inning must be completed.
- f) Prior to the game, the counselors and the umpire/judge must review the ground rules of that particular field, in accordance with the accepted practice of that field, e.g. ground rule double if ball goes into bushes, etc.
- g) Throwing the bat is an automatic out. The umpire will have discretion as to what is considered a thrown bat.
- h) Machzor Aleph - Tagging up from third base only. Machzor Bet - Tagging up from any base.
- i) The catcher must wear a mask at all times.

3) VOLLEYBALL & NEWCOMB

- a) A team must win two out of three games to decide the match. All 3 games must be played.
- b) 15 points are needed to win a game. (Nitzanim & Shtilim Newcomb play 11 point games.) A team must win by two points. Dead at 21.
- c) Each team member must play at least one full game.
- d) Net ball on a serve is out, a ball on the line is good even on a serve, the pole is out, no double taps, maximum three taps, if the ball hits the net it doesn't count as a tap.
- d) A player cannot put a foot into other team's court. A player's hand can cross over the net only 1) to follow through on a legal hit, 2) to block an opponent's shot after the opponent has hit the ball. Touching the net is never allowed.

4) HOCKEY

- a) Time: 3 eight-minute periods, stop time.
- b) Game can be official after half the game has been completed.
- c) One 3 minute, sudden-death overtime will be played if needed - then 3 man shootout.
- d) Each team receives one time out per game.
- e) Each team member must play at least three minutes per game.
- f) All boys must wear athletic supporters.

5) MACHANAYIM AND DODGEBALL

- a) Standard camp procedure for these activities, which must be discussed by the counselors and the judge before the game, will be in effect.
- b) Three games must be played.
- c) Games should be played with all balls live.
- d) Substitutes may only enter at the beginning of a new game.
- e) Each team member must play at least one game.

6) KICKBALL

- a) Seven innings constitute a game.
- b) A minimum of four innings with three outs each must be played.
- c) Substitutions follow the same rules as for softball.

7) TENNIS

- a) In order to win a set, a team must win 6 games. If it is tied at 5-5, a match can be won by either of the following two ways:
 - 1- By a 7-5 margin in a game by one team
 - 2- In the case of a 6-6 tie, a 7 point tie break is played
- b) No player may appear in more than one match.
- c) A ball on the line is good.

8) BBK

- a) Seven inning game.
- b) The shot at the basket counts as soon as the ball leaves the shooter's hands.
- b) A minimum of four innings with three outs each must be played.

9) FOOTBALL

- a) There will be two twenty-minute running halves.
- b) Three completions is a first down.
- c) Last two minutes of the game stop for an incomplete pass, out of bounds, or change of possession.
- d) The quarterback cannot go over the line until seven Mississippi rush has been said.

PRESENTATIONS AND PROJECTS

BAKE OFF: Each team must choose 6 Shtilim campers to construct and decorate a cake castle worth 100 points. A counselor must be assigned to supervise each team. You are to choose a castle to create and decorate based on either your area in Eretz Yisrael, religious figures of your team, or any other of your team's themes. The castle will be decorated with the raw materials that will be provided. A presentation of not more than 2 minutes will be given when the cakes are displayed. The baking contest will be judged, at 7:45 PM on Day I, based on: creativity, theme incorporation and relevance, presentation, and cleanup.

BERACHOT BEE: Each division will be given a list of brachot for 25 commonly eaten foods and will be tested on those brachot. The Berachot Bee will take place at 3:00 PM on Day III at the respective campuses.

CAMP PROJECT: Each team will construct an ארון קדש for this year's Camp Project. The theme for the ארוני קדש, separate from that of Color War at large, is בארץ ישראל, עם ישראל, עם תורת ישראל. The שומרון team will represent the first section of the theme (עם ישראל), the נגב the second, and the גליל the third. Each team will receive a completed wooden structure (box and frame) with which to work. The surfaces of the ארוני קדש must be artistically designed using wood on wood and should be three-dimensional, but may NOT exceed 4" in depth. Complete ideas, sketched out, must be presented to and approved by Elayne and Elisheva, and Rabbi Storch by lunch on Day I. A member of the art staff must approve ANY changes to the original sketch. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU REVIEW ALL RULES WITH YOUR GENERALS BEFORE YOU BEGIN YOUR PROJECTS. The Camp Project will be judged in the Mercazia, at 8:00 PM on Day III, on the basis of artistic appeal, quality of workmanship, representation of theme, originality of concept, use of space, durability, presentation, camper participation, clean up, and usability.

CHEER: Each team will present a team cheer in the Gym, at 8:00 PM on Day I, following supper. The cheer will be judged on the basis of: overall presentation, lyrics, shtick and appeal of song. Musical accompaniment is permissible. The Cheer should be used at activities, i.e. when a team wins a game. A member of the coordinating committee must approve the Cheer at breakfast of Day I. The shtick for the Cheer must be approved by the beginning of second shift dinner.

D'VAR TORAH: Each team will present one D'var Torah during Color War. All Divrei Torah must be submitted to the Coordinating Committee by dinner on Day I. The D'var Torah must be presented by a camper (not Machon) and must not exceed three minutes. It will be judged on the basis of content and presentation. The D'var Torah will be presented in the Mercazia at 8:00 PM on Day I and at second shift lunch on Days II and III.

MACCABIA: Alufim-Alufot and Machon will participate in a number of challenging races and competitions. Rosters for the races must be turned in to the Coordinating Committee by second shift dinner on Day I.

MATMON SEFORIM: Each team will select three boys and three girls per division in Machzor Bet to compete. The Matmon will take place during Sheurim on Day II for Alufim-Alufot and on Day III for Ilanot in the library. Each group will have forty (40) minutes to answer as many questions as possible from a list of 25 with the use of any source or reference material in the library.

MBP - MISHNAYOT BEAL PEH: Each team will choose 3 boys and 3 girls (one from younger, and 2 from older Shtilim for a total of 6). These campers will memorize and study 8 given Mishnayot relating to the theme. The judges will randomly choose 2 of the mishnayot to be explained and recited. The testing will take place at 3:30 PM on Day III in the library.

RABBATTON: Ilanot will be divided into four groups per team. Each group must be assigned a counselor. There will therefore be a total of 4 counselors per team. Each group will be assigned Bondis at the start of the event. At each Bondi the group will have three minutes to complete an assigned task and then will have fifteen seconds to proceed to the next Bondi. Each group can earn up to five points per activity.

SHALHEVET: Each team must submit five articles (one per division) for Shalhevet by the second day lunch as per instructions.

SHEALTIEL: The Shealtiel will consist of a set of questions based on material that will be distributed. Each team will select one boy and one girl per division to compete. The Shealtiel will be held on the night of Day II in the Mercazia.

SHIELD: The Shield should embody symbols associated with the themes of the teams and is to be presented on the second night. This year's Shield will be an artistic simulation of stained glass on a 3' x 3' sheet of Plexiglas, and will be permanently mounted. All Shields must be approved, before the work begins, by a member of the art staff. Complete ideas, sketched out, must be presented to and approved by Elayne and Elisheva, and Rabbi Storch, by lunch on Day I. You must keep in mind that the Shield will be hung as a display and not as a 3-dimensional object with working parts. The Shield will be judged on the basis of the following: artistic appeal, quality of workmanship, representation of theme, originality of concept, durability, appropriateness, camper participation, and presentation. The presentation is to consist of a detailed explanation of the Shield, and how it expresses the theme. The Shield will be presented on the night of Day II in the Mercazia.

SHIRIAH: Each Team will present two songs. The songs will be judged on the basis of clarity and precision, arrangements, knowledge of words, overall participation and – in the case of Song #2 – Choice of melody. ALL SONGS AND ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE APPROVED IN ADVANCE OF TEACHING by Michael Berl - by the end of breakfast – Day II. For complete instructions, please see attachment. Shiriah will take place on the night of Day III in the Mercazia.

STAFF BASKETBALL GAME: There will be a staff basketball game on Days I and II at 10:00 PM in the New Gym. A lottery at dinner of Day I will determine which team will receive the bye. Only those staff members that have participated or will participate in a Morashia event (i.e. coaching a game or working on art) will be allowed to play in the staff game. There will be severe point deductions for any team that does not adhere to this rule.

THEME PRESENTATION: Each Team will present its theme in the form of a skit to last a MAXIMUM of five (5) minutes. A maximum of two (2) minutes of the skit must be a dance presentation. Boys MUST be included in the dance. No introduction should be necessary for either portion. The skit MAY NOT include specific mentions of any member of the camp staff or any camper. It will be judged on basis of representation of theme, execution, creativity, and flow and relevance of the dance portion. The skit portion must be approved by Jason Koslowe, and the dance portion must be approved by Dina Brilliant by second shift breakfast on Day II. The Theme Presentation will be presented on the night of Day II in the Mercazia.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELORS:

- 1) COUNSELORS MUST FIRST FULFILL THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES TO THEIR BUNKS BEFORE PROCEEDING TO MORASHIA EVENTS.
- 2) It is the major duty of all counselors and generals to encourage all work to be done by campers. Counselors are to serve primarily as advisors.
- 3) No articles are to be removed from the "A" Building, HC Huts, Dining Room, Arts & Crafts shops or Mercazia without prior permission from those in charge. All items removed with permission must be returned to their proper places. Points will be deducted for items not returned and if the assigned art areas are not cleaned daily.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Stress is not on competition but on emphasis of the themes delineated and sportsmanship. All activities should be conducted with the spirit of good fellowship. To win is not as important as to compete to the best of your ability. Therefore, all counselors are requested to make certain that all campers, no matter how weak in athletics, shall participate. Any infraction of this rule will result in a substantial loss of points for the team involved.

Individual judges may recommend an award or deduction of up to five (5) points per incident for attitude, spirit, sportsmanship, supervision etc.

Discussions and protests of controversial decisions should never be held in the presence of campers.

BUNK CLEAN-UP SCHEDULE: Bunk inspection will be done by the division heads or head counselors. Points may be deducted at the discretion of the inspector.

COVERAGE: Bunks MUST be covered during the morning cleanup, rest hour, evening preparation and bedtime. Responsibility for this coverage will be divided among the teams such that each team will be responsible for a set number of bunks. A list of the covering counselors is to be presented to the Coordinating Committee each evening by Maariv. Severe deductions will be made for any bunk left uncovered.

TEFILAH: In the Bet Knesset, campers and counselors will sit by bunk. Baalei Tefila will be chosen according to the regular rotation. No camper or counselor may absent himself/herself from Tefila.

STRUCTURE OF THE TEAMS:

Each team is required to designate coordinators in the areas of Art, Sports, Track and Field, and Swimming. There must be machzor coordinators for sports, track and swim.

GENERAL RULES:

CURFEW: CAMPERS & COUNSELORS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO STAY UP AFTER CURFEW, NOR ARE THEY TO ARISE BEFORE WAKEUP, WITHOUT SPECIAL PERMISSION FROM THE HEAD COUNSELORS & THE COORDINATING COMMITTEE. A limited number of campers, Machon campers and counselors may be allowed an extended curfew. Their names MUST be submitted on a special curfew extension form to the Coord. Committee by 7:30 PM. Names should be listed in order of preference. Extended curfews will be for one hour only [past the person's normal curfew] unless otherwise specified. Generals, Lieutenant Generals and Captains have an automatic one hour extension.

ENTRIES: Complete written lists of starting and substitute players in games must be submitted to the judges before the start of the game. If entries are not submitted on time, the event may be forfeited at the discretion of the judges. Entries may be changed only upon the consent of the judges. Any camper may be barred from participation in events by the medical staff.

SCORES: Judges should submit scores to a member of the Scoring or the Assignment Committee at the conclusion of each activity. Where no judge is assigned, the team responsible for equipment is also responsible for scores.

DINING ROOM: General decorum must be maintained and the teams will be judged accordingly. At least two generals per team must be at each meal.

O.D.: The O.D. schedule will follow regular rotation. Generals may make substitutions only with permission of the Head Counselors.

CHANGES: All activities, rules and regulations are subject to change without prior notice at the discretion of the Coordinating Committee. This will be done only if unusual circumstances indicate the necessity for such a change.

PRORATING: A modified prorating system (Olympic scoring) will be used for all sports except where otherwise noted. 20% of the points will go to the winner. The remainder of the points will be divided on a per-cent basis. In general, the following will be the total point value for each sport:

In case of shut-outs, or wide point differences, certain adjustments are made in the prorating system. The Scoring Committee may be consulted for details.

PROTESTS: Protests must be submitted in writing, signed by the counselors supervising the activity, and countersigned by the General. The protest is to be submitted to Rabbi Elly Storch by the mealtime immediately following the event in question.

PREPARATION & PROMPTNESS: Teams must report to activities promptly. Failure to be prompt may lead to the forfeiture of points. All campers in the division must be present at the activity of their division (unless the camper is taking part in another supervised activity). Participants should wear, wherever and whenever possible, the team color.

MEALS: No camper, counselor or General is to be absent from any meal without the prior permission of the Head Counselor & Coordinating Committee.
