ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES – RULES AND REGULATIONS

1) BASKETBALL

- a) Machon Banim, Alufim & Ilanot Banim: 20 minute running halves; all others: 15 minute running halves. The last 2 minutes of each half in all divisions will be played stop time.
- b) Every team member must play at least three minutes.
- c) If time runs out, the game is officially over after at least one half of the game has been played.
- d) Each team has four time-outs per game.
- e) "One and one" goes into effect on the seventh team foul within a half. Two shots on the 10th foul per half.
- f) A player fouls out of the game on his/her fifth personal foul.
- g) One team will be responsible for keeping score and fouls; the other team will keep time.
- h) Overtimes will be 3 minutes, 2 minutes running, last minute stop time.
- i) All technical fouls will result in two foul shots and possession of the ball.
- j) For scoring purposes, a 30-point victory is equivalent to a shut-out.

2) BBK

- a) Seven-inning game.
- b) The shot at the basket counts as soon as the ball leaves the shooter's hands.
- c) A minimum of four innings with three outs each must be played.

3) FOOTBALL

- a) There will be two twenty-minute running halves.
- b) Three completions is a first down. Only one first down per drive.
- c) Last two minutes of the game, the clock stops for an incomplete pass, out of bounds, or change of possession.
- d) The quarterback cannot go over the line until the referee has audibly counted a seven-Mississippi rush.
- e) If time runs out, a game is considered complete after one half of play.

4) HOCKEY

- a) Time: 3 eight-minute periods. Machzor Bet Boys play 3 ten-minute periods. The last 2 minutes of all periods are stop-time.
- b) Games are official after half the game has been completed.
- c) One three-man, three-minute sudden-death overtime will be played if needed, followed by a 3 man shootout. Overtime periods are 2½-minutes long, stop time.
- d) Each team receives one time-out per game.
- e) Each team member must play at least three minutes per game.
- f) All boys must wear athletic supporters.

5) KICKBALL

- a) 7 innings constitute a game; a minimum of 4 innings with 3 outs must be played.
- b) Substitutions follow the same rules as softball (Rule C, above).

6) DODGEBALL AND PIN DODGEBALL

- a) Standard camp procedure for these activities - which must be discussed by the counselors and the judge before the game will be in effect.
- b) Three games must be played.
- c) Games should be played with all balls live.
- d) Substitutes may only enter at the beginning of a new game.
- e) Each team member must play at least one game.

7) ROCK CLIMBING

- a) All the rules of Rock Climbing will be as per the on-site instructions of the Rock Climbing Staff.

8) SOFTBALL

- a) Machon and Machzor Bet - 6 innings; Machzor Aleph - 5 innings.
- b) A minimum of three full innings will constitute a game.
- c) A maximum of 10 players will play the field. All team members will have a spot in the batting order. Team members will rotate in the field.
- d) Each team member must play in the field at least one inning and have at least one turn at bat.
- e) No inning may begin later than 5 minutes before the end of the period. The inning must be completed.
- f) Prior to the game, the counselors and the umpire/judge must review the ground rules of that particular field, in accordance with the accepted practice of that field, e.g. ground rule double if ball goes into bushes, etc.
- g) Throwing the bat is an automatic out. The umpire will have discretion as to what is considered a thrown bat.
- h) Machzor Aleph - Tagging up from third base only. Machzor Bet - Tagging up from any base.
- i) The catcher must wear a mask at all times.

9) TENNIS

- a) In order to win a set, a team must win 10 games; one set wins the match.
- b) A ball on the line is good.

10) VOLLEYBALL & NEWCOMB

- a) A team must win two out of three games to win. All 3 games must be played.
- b) 15 points are needed to win a game. (Nitzanim & Shtilim Newcomb play 11 point games.) A team must win by two points. Dead at 21.
- c) Each team member must play at least one full game.
- d) Net ball on a serve is out, a ball on the line is good even on a serve, the pole is out, no double taps, maximum three taps, if the ball hits the net it doesn't count as a tap.
- e) A player cannot put a foot into other team's court. A player's hand can cross over the net only :
 - i. To follow through on a legal hit,
 - ii. To block an opponent's shot after the opponent has hit the ball. Touching the net is never allowed.

PRESENTATIONS AND PROJECTS

BAKE-OFF: Each team must choose five (5) Machzor Aleph campers, and assign a counselor to supervise the group. Each team will receive pre-baked cake from Ricki Nat. They will have 1 hour to decorate the cake using raw materials provided. The bakeoff will take place at 4:00 PM on Day I in the Baking room. The final products will be judged at the night program of Day I. Cake decoration will be judged based on creativity, theme, cleanliness, (non-)waste of materials and cleanup.

BERACHOT BEE: Campers will be tested on the following berachot/tefillot:

Machzor Aleph – *Al Hamichyah & Asher Yatzar*

Machzor Bet – *Al HaMichyah & Modim Derabanan*

Machon - *Modim Derabanan & Hamapil*.

In addition, all divisions will given a list of foods for which to memorize the *bracha rishonah* and the *bracha achronah*. No partial credit will be given. The Berachot Bee will take place at 3:00 PM on Day III at the respective capuses.

CAMP PROJECT: Each team will design a map of the camp on a ½ inch piece of plywood. No element of the map may rise higher than 2½ inches from the face of the plywood. Each map will be placed at a different location throughout camp so the “you are here” marker should not be attached to the camp project. The map must be decorated in a manner appropriate for a camp environment and does not need to communicate information about the team’s theme. It does, however, need to be highly durable, for these maps will be placed outdoors and exposed to the elements. Paint and wood can be used to assemble the project; the use of any medium other than these must be approved by a member of the Color War Art Committee. Complete ideas, sketched out, must be approved by Fannie Elefant AND Yael Jaff by Lunch on Day I. A member of the Color War Art Committee must approve any changes made to this original sketch. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU REVIEW ALL RULES WITH YOUR GENERALS BEFORE YOU BEGIN CREATING YOUR PROJECTS. The Camp Project will be judged on the basis of the following: artistic appeal, usability, quality of workmanship, originality of concept, durability, appropriateness, camper participation and presentation. The presentation is to consist of an explanation of the map’s unique features and may not exceed 3 minutes in length. The Camp Projects will be presented on the night of Day II in the Mercazia..

CHEER: Each team will present a team cheer in the Mercazia at 8:00 PM on Day I following supper. The most important judging criteria will be **USABILITY** of the cheer throughout Color War. Points will also be awarded for overall presentation, shtick, and appeal of song (catchiness). The cheer should be no longer then ten (10) lines, so it can be cheered throughout Color War at games, meals, etc. Musical accompaniment is permissible but not necessary. On Day III, additional points will be awarded to the team whose cheer is most well known and has been cheered the most during Color War. Chavie Balsam must approve the cheer by first-shift breakfast of Day I. The shtick for the cheer must be approved Chavie Balsam by the end of first-shift dinner.

DANCE: Girls Campus will present a dance presentation in the Mercazia following the theme presentation on the night of Day II. The dance presentation should represent your theme. The dance presentation is to last a maximum of four (4) minutes, and include a minimum of fourteen (14) participants (Machon and Staff can be included). It will be judged on overall presentation, creativity, costumes, and choice of music. The dance presentation must be approved by Yael Jaff by first shift breakfast on Day II. Each team must give the technical staff a tape of their music for the dance by first-shift dinner. Each team’s music should be on one tape or CD.

D'VAR TORAH: Each team will present one D'var Torah during Color War. All Divrei Torah must be submitted to Avi Hochman by First-Shift dinner on Day I. The D'var Torah must be presented by a camper (not Machon) and may not exceed three minutes. It will be judged on the basis of content and presentation. The D'var Torah will be presented in the Mercazia at 8:00 on Day I and at lunch on Days II and III.

FISH-OFF: Two boys (1A, 1M) and two girls (1A, 1M) from each team will compete in the Fish-Off. A complete list of all participants must be submitted to Moshe Rosenberg by 2nd shift dinner on Day I. Points will be awarded based on type of fish and size of fish. A bonus will also be awarded to the team that catches the most overall fish. The Fish-Off will take place at 5:30 in the morning on Day II at the fishing dock. Boys will be picked up at their HC at precisely 5:15 AM; girls at 5:20 AM. Latecomers will not be allowed to compete.

MACCABIA: Alufim-Alufot and Machon will participate in a number of challenging races and competitions. Rosters for the races must be given Moshe Rosenberg by second shift dinner on Day I.

MACHZOR ALEPH CAMP PROJECT: Each team will construct two bencher holders to be hung on the wall of the dining room. These bencher holders will be assembled from parts provided; teams will be responsible for assembly and decoration. ONLY Machzor Aleph campers will work on this project, which is included in Color War for the specific purpose of showcasing their artistic talents. This project may be worked on on Day II only, from 4:00 to 6:00 PM, in the Girls Woodshop, by exactly four (4) campers per team, and will be presented for judging on that night. A roster listing participants and the counselor assigned to the activity must be turned in to Yael Jaff by the end of lunch on Day II. No team will be allowed to begin work until all four campers and the covering counselor are present. The Machzor Aleph Camp Project will be judged on the basis of the following: artistic appeal, quality of workmanship and durability. There will be no presentation.

MATMON SEFORIM: Each team will select three boys and three girls per division in Machzor Bet to compete. The Matmon will take place during Sheurim on Day II for Alufim-Alufot and on Day III for Ilanot in the library. All rules will be explained at the Matmon.

MBP - MISHNAYOT BEAL PEH: Each team will choose 3 boys and 3 girls (one from younger, and 2 from older Shtilim for a total of 6). These campers will memorize and study five (5) given Mishnayot relating to the theme. The judges will choose randomly 2 of the Mishnayot to be explained and recited. The testing will take place at 3:30 PM on Day III in the library.

RABBATTON: Ilanot will be divided into four groups per team. Each group must be assigned a counselor. There should be a total of 4 counselors per team. Each group will be assigned Bondis at the start of the event. At each Bondi the group will have three minutes to complete an assigned task and then will have fifteen seconds to proceed to the next Bondi. Each group can earn up to five points per activity.

SHALHEVET: Each team must submit five articles (one per division) for Shalhevet to Chavie Balsam by lunch on Day II as per instructions.

SHEALTIEL: The Shealtiel will consist of a set of questions based on material that will be distributed. Each team will select one boy and one girl per division to compete. Shealtiel will take place on the night of Day II. A list of participants must be given to Avi Hochman by the end of Lunch on Day II.

SHIELD: The Shield should embody symbols associated with the themes of the teams and must contain the name of your team and the Hebrew year. The Shield will be designed and built on a 4'x4' piece of ½" plywood, can be three-dimensional but may not exceed 3" in depth. All Shields must be approved, before work begins, by a member of the Color War Art Committee. Complete ideas, sketched out, must be approved by Fannie Elefant, Sandy Weiner and Yael Jaff by lunch on Day I. A member of the Color War Art Committee must approve any changes made to this original sketch. **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU REVIEW ALL RULES WITH YOUR GENERALS BEFORE YOU BEGIN BUILDING YOUR PROJECTS.** You must keep in mind that the Shield will be judged as a display: **NO SHIELD MAY CONTAIN ANY MOVING PARTS.** The Shield will be judged on the basis of the following: artistic appeal, quality of workmanship, representation of theme, originality of concept, durability, appropriateness, camper participation, cleanup of space and presentation. The presentation is to consist of a detailed explanation of the Shield and how it relates to the theme and may not exceed 3 minutes in length. The Shield will be presented on the night of Day III in the Mercazia.

SHIRIAH: Each Team will present two songs. The songs will be judged on the basis of clarity and precision, harmony and arrangements, knowledge of words and overall participation. ALL SONGS AND ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE APPROVED IN ADVANCE OF TEACHING by Michael Berl by the end of breakfast – Day II. For complete instructions, please see attachment. All Shiriah shtick, including stand-ups, must be approved by Chavie Balsam by second-shift dinner on Day III.

SILENT LUNCH: Lunch on Day II will be completely silent. There will be no talking of any kind by generals, Machon, counseling, and non-counseling staff members. The exceptions will be the reciter of the D'var Torah, the sayer of the bracha achrona, and any announcements that need to be made. It is permissible to say Amen to the Bracha Achrona. Eating, serving, passing up, and all movements should be kept to a minimum. Silent lunch will be judged on quietness of the teams and attentiveness during the D'var Torah.

STAFF BASKETBALL/MACHON SOFTBALL: There will be boys and girls staff basketball games on Days I and II at 10:45 PM in the New Gym and on Girls Courts. A lottery at dinner of Day I will determine which teams will receive the bye. Only those staff members that have participated or will participate in a Morashia event (e.g. coaching a game or working on art) will be allowed to play in the staff game. There will be severe point deductions for any team that does not adhere to this rule. There will also be boys Machon softball games, weather permitting, on Days I and II at 10:45 PM on Field G. (If Day I softball game is rained out, Day II game is cancelled.) A lottery at dinner of Day I will determine which teams will receive the bye.

THEME PRESENTATION: Each team will present its theme in an audio-video presentation that is to last a maximum of six minutes. No introduction is allowed; the entire presentation must be pre-recorded and will be coordinated by David Tuchman, out of the Tech Office in the A Building. The theme will be judged on development of theme, creativity and professionalism. The presentation may not include specific references to any staff member or camper. Each team's theme coordinator(s) must attend a meeting with David Tuchman at 4:00 PM on Day I in the Tech Office to discuss procedures for filming, editing and equipment use. The presentation's concept and script must be approved by Judah Rhine by breakfast on Day II and will be presented on the night of Day II in the Mercazia.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELORS

COUNSELORS MUST FIRST FULFILL THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES TO THEIR BUNKS – AS PER INSTRUCTIONS FROM HCs AND DHs - BEFORE PROCEEDING TO MORASHIA EVENTS.

It is the major duty of all counselors and generals to encourage all work to be done by campers. Counselors are to serve primarily as advisors.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Stress is not on competition but on emphasis of the themes delineated and sportsmanship. All activities should be conducted with the spirit of good fellowship. To win is not as important as to compete to the best of your ability. Therefore, all counselors are requested to make certain that all campers, no matter how weak in athletics, shall participate. Individual judges may recommend an award or deduction of up to five (5) points per incident for attitude, spirit, sportsmanship, supervision etc.

Discussions and protests of controversial decisions should never be held in the presence of campers.

BUNK CLEAN-UP SCHEDULE: Bunk inspection will be done by the division heads or head counselors. Points may be deducted at the discretion of the inspector.

COVERAGE: Bunks MUST be covered during the morning cleanup, rest hour, evening preparation and bedtime. Responsibility for this coverage will be divided among the teams such that each team will be responsible for a set number of bunks. A list of the covering counselors is to be presented to the Coordinating Committee each evening. Severe deductions will be made for any bunk left uncovered.

TEFILAH: In the Bet Knesset, campers and counselors will sit by bunk. Baalei Tefila will be chosen according to the regular rotation. No camper or counselor may absent himself/herself from Tefila.

STRUCTURE OF THE TEAMS: Each team is required to designate coordinators in the areas of Art, Sports, Track and Field, and Swimming. There must be machzor coordinators for sports, track and swim.

GENERAL RULES

CURFEW: CAMPERS & COUNSELORS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO STAY UP AFTER CURFEW, NOR ARE THEY TO ARISE BEFORE REVEILLE, WITHOUT SPECIAL PERMISSION FROM THE HEAD COUNSELORS & THE COORDINATING COMMITTEE. A limited number of campers, Machon campers and counselors may be allowed an extended curfew. Their names MUST be submitted on a special curfew extension form to the Coordinating Committee by second-shift dinner. Names should be listed in order of preference. Extended curfews will be for one hour (past the individual's curfew) only, unless otherwise specified. Generals, Lieutenant Generals and Captains have an automatic one-hour extension.

ENTRIES: Complete written lists of starting and substitute players in games must be submitted to the judges before the start of the game. If entries are not submitted on time, the event may be forfeited at the discretion of the judges. Entries may be changed only upon the consent of the judges. Any camper may be barred from participation in events by the medical staff.

SCORES: Judges should submit scores to a member of the Scoring or the Assignment Committee at the conclusion of each activity. Where no judge is assigned, the team responsible for equipment is also responsible for scores.

DINING ROOM: General decorum must be maintained and the teams will be judged accordingly. At least two Officers per team must be at each dinner shift, and all Officers must be at breakfast and lunch.

O.D.: The O.D. schedule will follow regular rotation. Generals may make substitutions only with permission of the Head Counselors.

CHANGES: All activities, rules and regulations are subject to change without prior notice at the discretion of the Coordinating Committee. This will be done only if unusual circumstances indicate the necessity for such a change.

PRORATING: A modified prorating system (Olympic scoring) will be used for all sports except where otherwise noted. 20% of the points will go to the winner. The remainder of the points will be divided on a percent basis. In general, the following will be the total point value for each sport:

In case of shut-outs, or wide point differences, certain adjustments are made in the prorating system. The Scoring Committee may be consulted for details.

PROTESTS: Protests must be submitted in writing, signed by the counselors supervising the activity, and countersigned by the General. The protest is to be submitted to Seth Dimbert by the mealtime immediately following the event in question.

PREPARATION & PROMPTNESS: Teams must report to activities promptly. Failure to be prompt may lead to the forfeiture of points. All campers in the division must be present at the activity of their division (unless the camper is taking part in another supervised activity). Participants should wear, wherever and whenever possible, the team color.

MEALS: No camper, counselor or General is to be absent from any meal without the prior permission of the Head Counselor & Coordinating Committee.
